- 4. All courses must be completed with a "C" grade or higher to continue in the VN program.
- 5. Students completing the program satisfactorily are eligible to apply to take the state board examination for licensure.
- 6. Any student with a criminal conviction can be denied licensure. Contact the Board of Vocational Nursing to clarify limitations for licensure. www.bvnpt.ca.gov
- 7. Students accepted into the VN program who receive substandard grades must successfully complete a plan of remediation developed by the VN Faculty in order to be considered for readmission into the VN program.
- 8. Applicants should be aware that they might have to limit hours of employment due to the extensive scheduled hours in the Vocational Nursing program. Requirements include clinical assignments, theory, plus adequate time to prepare for clinical & theory courses.
